## KEY STATISTICS, fiscal year 10-1-10 to 9-30-11 compared to 10-1-09 to 9-30-10

The amount of total income for all 4 branches of CCAC increased 19.5%, due in part to active fundraising efforts on behalf of CCAC in general, the railcar restoration fund, summer concerts and Wilson Auditorium

- Total consignment and non-consignment CCAC gallery sales increased 11%
- Amount paid to artists for artwork sold in the CCAC gallery increased 35% (artists receive 70% of price)
- Amount of income from adult and children's classes increased 71% (due to higher enrollment, not prices)
- Net amount from Charitable Gaming increased 15.6%
- Amount of donations to CCAC across all 4 branches increased 11%
- Amount of dues paid by members increased 30%
